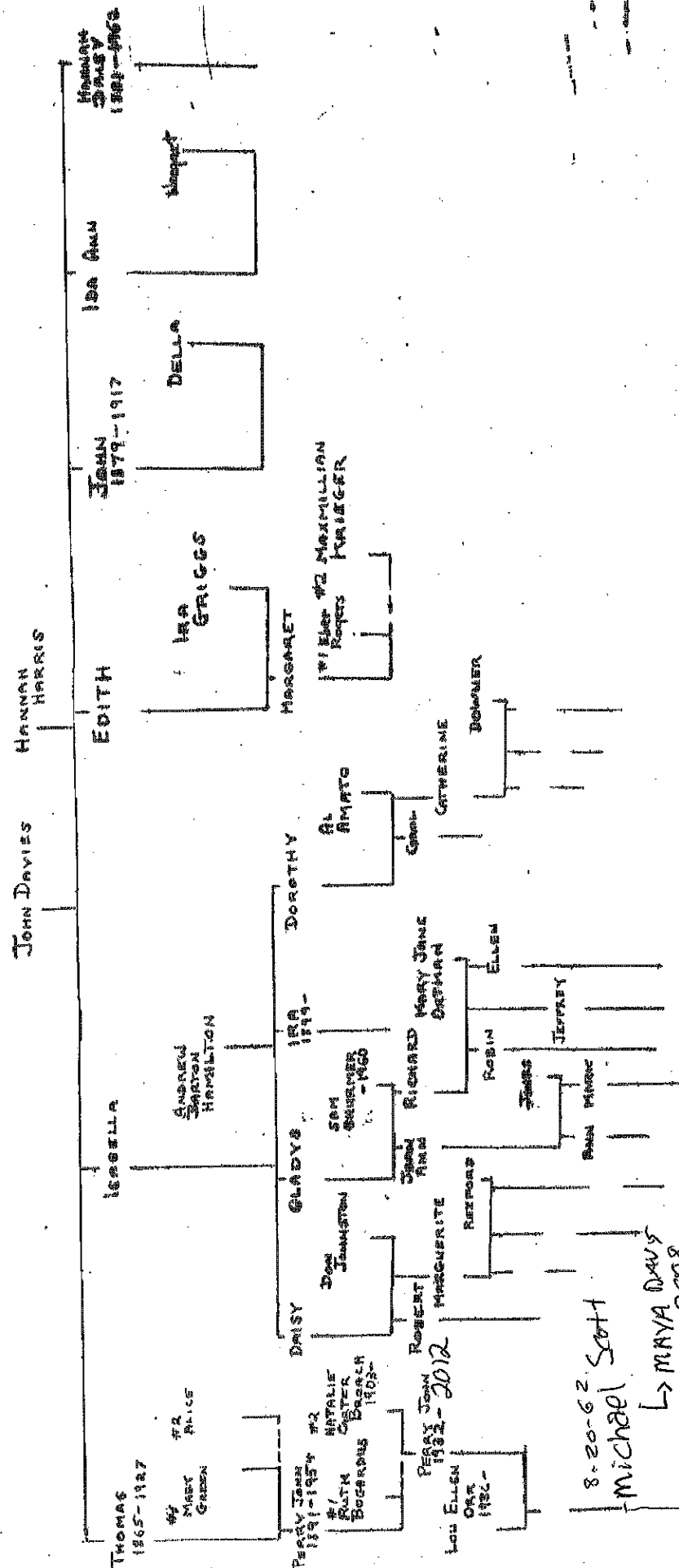

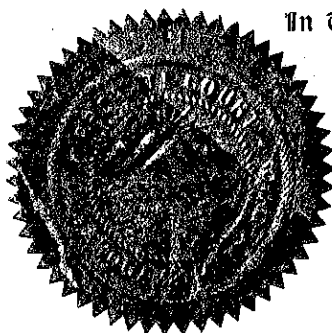
CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION
The United States of America
THE STATE OF OHIO  **CUYAHOGA COUNTY, S.**
IN THE PROBATE COURT

Be it Remembered, That at a term of said Court, begun and held at the City of Cleveland, within and for said County, on the 1st day of January in the year one thousand, eight hundred and seventy-four personally came John Davis an Alien, and native of Wales and made application to be naturalized under the laws of the United States. And it appearing to the Court that the said John Davis had made his declaration of intention to become a Citizen of the United States, according to law, that he had been a resident of the United States for at least five years last past, and of this State for at least one year last past, and that, during that time, he had behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same; and having made oath, in open Court, that he would support the Constitution of the United States, and that he Absolutely and Entirely Renounced and Abjured all Allegiance and Fidelity to every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever and particularly to Victoria Queen he was, on the 17th day of March one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, and at the term aforesaid, duly admitted to Citizenship of the United States of America, and is therefore entitled to all the rights and privileges of a Naturalized Citizen.

In Testimony Whereof, I hereunto subscribe my name and affix the seal of said Court, at the court house in the City of Cleveland, this 17th day of Dec 1907.
